

## Spring term 4 Home Learning

### 'Equality and Diversity'



This term we will be exploring and promoting 'Equality and Diversity' through workshops, our Collective Worship theme 'Justice', our English lessons, World Book Day and PSHE lessons.

This term's home learning task is to complete an '**Equality and Diversity**' project. Ideas **could** include:

- A poster to explain and celebrate our Hearing Impairment Resource Base (did you know we are the only primary HIRB in Wiltshire?)
- A rap about equality and diversity
- Examples of how you have seen equality and diversity in everyday life
- Research into a future career – What does this job involve? What route do you need to take?
- Information/fact file about someone who has stood up for what they believe in and made a difference to people's lives
- Information/fact file about someone who has not let their gender, disability, ethnicity, age stop them from achieving incredible things
- A well-known story rewritten to promote diversity – Could you change the gender of the main character in a fairy tale? Could the main character have a disability?
- An interview with someone who doesn't have a 'gender typical' job - How did they get into their career? What do they find difficult? Have they had to break people's stereotypes?

Important reminders:

- Although there is no expectation with quantity, time spent on task or style, **there is an expectation of quality.** We expect books to be looked after, well presented and neat.
- This project could be typed (and stuck into books), written by hand or a combination of both.
- The project is compulsory for Key Stage 2 pupils and optional for Key Stage 1 pupils.
