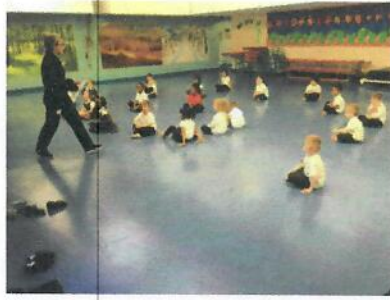
15th March— Red Nose Day

We invite children to dress down for the day. Classes will be making cakes that can be purchased during the school day for 20pence each. All proceeds will go to Children in need.



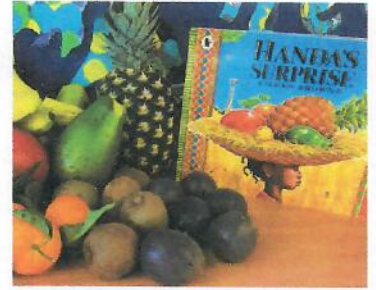
EYFS
