



Play Worker – Apple Tree Club

We require a play worker at the Apple Tree Club, based at Finedon Infant School, to cover a period of maternity leave. The Apple Tree Club offers before and after school child care for children aged four to eleven and also open during every school holiday.

We are seeking someone who:

- enjoys working with children
- has a caring personality and can empathise with young children
- has the ability to be flexible and use their own initiative to deal with different situations
- can work as part of a team and has good communication skills
- respects the confidentiality of pupils and staff
- is happy to undertake training as appropriate for their duties
- is willing to contribute to the wider aims and activities of the Apple Tree Club

An appropriate level 3 qualification would be of benefit, but is not essential

Hours of work - 3:15 – 5:30 p.m. on a Monday, and 3:15 to 4:30 p.m. Tuesday to Friday, with the flexibility to stay until 5:45 p.m. should numbers be high, on the days that the school is open to pupils. In addition, there is a requirement to work a minimum of three full days each week the club is open during the school holidays.

Rate of pay: NJC Grade A scale point 6 £16,394 pro rata (£8.50 per hour)

The position is temporary to cover a period of maternity leave, and is available for up to one year, or the return of the post holder, whichever is sooner. There could be the opportunity for some hours once the maternity cover is ended. The successful applicant will be able to start as soon as all necessary checks have been completed.
