Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you managed to have a restful half term break and that the children enjoyed playing with their amazing monster puppets. Our topic for this term is 'Fire! Fire!' and we will be focusing on the Great Fire of London.

Homework

Thank you for continually supporting your child with their homework. We will still be sending home spellings and a maths/reading task for your child to complete each week. We would like to encourage you to also support your child to become fluent in recalling the following maths facts: doubles and halves, near doubles, one more and one less, two more and two less and adding and subtracting 10 and 0. We also encourage you to be regularly accessing Times Tables RockStars at home to support your child with learning their 2, 5 and 10 multiplication and division facts.

PE

Year 2 have PE on Tuesday and Friday afternoons but we recommend that kit is kept in school all week for extra sports activities or as a change of clothes.

A reminder that PE kits should consist of: navy blue shorts, a plain white (or house coloured) T-shirt and trainers for indoor PE; and jogging bottoms and a sweatshirt for outdoor PE. If possible, it is also advisable to have an additional pair of shoes for outside with a spare plastic bag as the field can be muddy.
