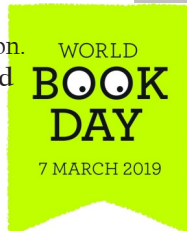

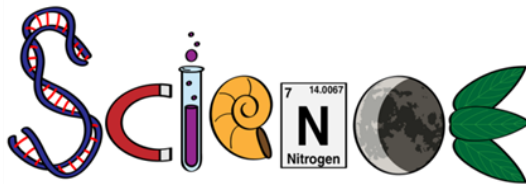
IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO PARENTS
