What a great success! It was great to see so many of you attending your consultations with our staff, thank you for your continued support with your children's learning. The Teachers enjoyed sharing the children's achievements with you and having the opportunity to discuss further their next steps to even greater success. Following our parent surveys, I would like to share some of the results with you...

- 94% of pupils are happy at Roach Vale Primary School
- 92% of pupils feels safe and that their children make good progress
- 98% of parents think their children are well taught
- 84% of parents think the school is well led and managed
- 80% think the school responds well to concerns
- 92% of parents think they are well informed about their child's progress
- And its great to hear that 89% of parents would recommend Roach Vale to other parents

We always welcome feedback and continually look for ways to improve the learning experience for our families.
