

LATE COLLECTION OF CHILDREN FROM AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

If you collect your child after they have attended an after-school club, please ensure that you are present to meet them at the main entrance by the club's published finishing time.

A small number of parents are regularly arriving up to 15 minutes late to collect their child. Records of late collections are now kept and where it is clear that a parent is regularly failing to arrive on time, the child will be sent to YOYO Club and a charge will be made for their services. Parents at risk of this will be notified in writing before any child care charge is applied.

We appreciate that there may be one-off circumstances such as traffic or a sudden family emergency that make a parent late for collection, and the above is not aimed at those situations. If you find that you will be late please telephone the school office to let them know.

CLASS OPEN AFTERNOONS:

The Year 4 and Key Stage 1 Class Open Afternoons take place next week at the times published on the school website. The remaining Class Open Afternoons will be held the following week. Please wait in the main entrance to be taken to the classroom.

As usual we request that pre-school-aged children are not brought to this event. This is because of the very limited space in classrooms for prams, the potential dangers present in the classrooms for young children and the fact that in the past the presence of some pre-school children who have not been supervised properly has spoilt events for other parents and children.

If there is absolutely no-one who can look after your child whilst you attend, and you will not be able to come as a result, please visit the school office to discuss the matter.
