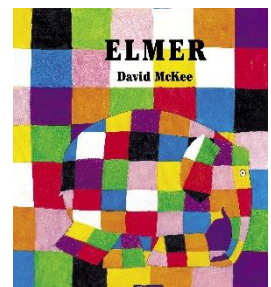
WORLD BOOK DAY
