Focus: Sheep

Free Play:

We will have the movement mat + peanut, the trampoline, the cube with noisy farm animal torches, Theraputty with hidden animals, sheep counting activity, shape sorter, farm puzzles, magnetic balls with sticks, corks with bottles and tubes, drawing on the magic board and slime. Our story from last week-Spot Goes to the Farm will be out with the props that support it and we will have a hobby horse to play the riding on the horse game.

Demonstrated activities: (these happen in the order shown)

- Sticking cotton wool onto a sheep template
- Slime explore
- Sponge painting a sheep
- Snipping playdough with scissors
- Water toys-Look at me demo

Spontaneous Interaction:

Space hoppers, Pirate dressing up, ball tower

Game:

This week the children have to place the sheep in the trailer of the tractor and then drive the tractor to the farm, unload the sheep, feed them and then make them lie down to go to sleep.
