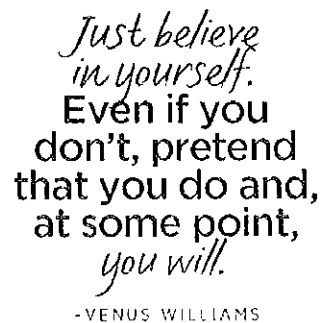
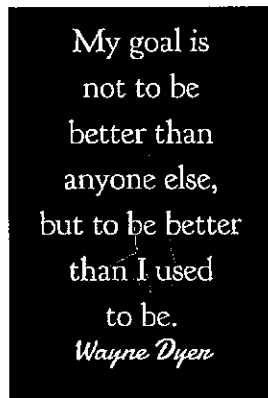

Please ensure that your child is well rested over the weekend and that they are in the best frame of mind possible and arrive at school on time each morning – as you, we want them to be given the best opportunity to do their absolute best during the tests that they are working so hard for; last time we completed assessments, there were some children whose tests didn't reflect their full potential and obviously the closer we get to SATs week, the more important it becomes for children to be putting in maximum effort and increasing in confidence. We know that the children are working incredibly hard and we are also incredibly grateful for all the support you continue to give them at home too.

Just as a reminder, the dates for the statutory national SATs week are Monday 13th May – Thursday 16th May so please ensure that you don't book any appointments during school time over the course of those days.
