Week Beginning 4th March 2019

This week will be continuing learning about our topic 'Our Changing World', looking at the changes which happen as spring comes. We will be creating an outside garden to plant real bulbs, seeds and vegetables and will be making a British animal sanctuary in our role play area, talking about how we can create safe spaces for our wildlife. Our Outdoor Exploration session this week will focus on making homes for our animals and minibeasts.

Additionally, we will also be talking about Pancake Day on Tuesday, and doubling chocolate chips as our topping. In Maths this week we will be learning about doubling, using a variety of different real life objects.

We will also be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday, so please come to school dressed up as a character from a book we have read or as an adjective, such as 'glittery'. We look forward to seeing all your costumes! Some books we have read this year include; Owl Babies, The Gruffalo, The Enormous Turnip, Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, The Rainbow Fish, Supertato, Room on the Broom, We're Going on a Bear Hunt, Funnybones and Whatever next!
