

In Science, the children will:

- Describe different materials and their purpose and begin to categories items based on what they're made from
- Analyse materials and their qualities
- Test and evaluate best material to make a boat



In history, the children will:

- Learn about the explorer Christopher Columbus
- Use a range of sources to discover information about him
- Understand his significant place in history

In literacy, the children will:

- Write a diary entry based on Columbus' journey
- Create a fact file for Columbus
- Recount his journey
- Labels, lists and captions
- Continue applying all graphemes, high frequency words taught in phonics
- Begin to answer inference questions about what has been read or what they have read

In maths the children will:

- Will begin to count in 2, 5 and 10
- Investigate numbers within 10 and ways in which to make them
- Learn to add and subtract one digit
- Shape 2D and 3D
- Patterns



In PE, the children will:
