What can we do to improve behaviour in lessons?

Yr4 - Think before talk/ interrupt, listen,  
Recognition board with Expectations & House point at end -

Yr6 - Reward good behaviour - sticker teachers, Harsher punishments,  
Teachers have more patience.

Yr1 - Track speaker, fold arms, finger on lips.

Yr3 - Follow instructions first time, child model good behaviour.

Yr2 - Listen & focus more.

Yr5 - Use learning partner if need to know what to do. Concentrating properly. Stricker teacher. Reminders Discuss with child if distracting. Write lines.

On the playground?

Yr4 - If annoyed outside move away from friend see adult. More bins so don't litter.

Yr6 - More adults. More rewards. More constructive advice. More monitors

Yr1 - Teachers help friendships - young leaders help with games.

Yr3 - More places to go. More things to do. More monitors. Assembly to remind us

Yr5 - When people are rude - reflect after lunch. More adults - spread out.

In the dinner hall?

Yr4 - Talk less, Talk quieter. Longer than 1 min punishment. Don't waste food  
More adults to show younger ones where to stand & to keep in line quieter.

Yr6 - Properly enforce time limits - 1 minute silence not enforced. More kitchen staff so  
serving quicker. More supervision of line.

Yr1 - a little noisy

Yr3 - More hall monitors. Older children should act as good role models.

Yr2 - Better manners & Lining up.

Yr5 - Timeout if disruptive
