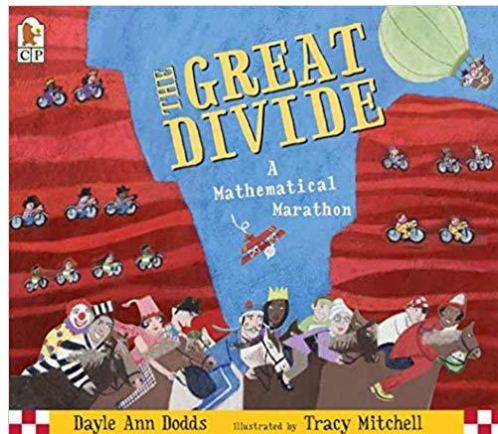

World Book Day

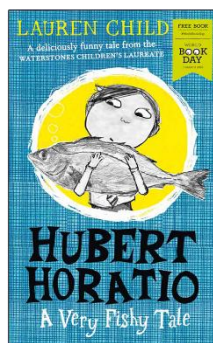
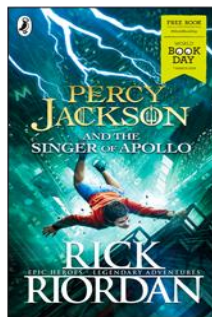
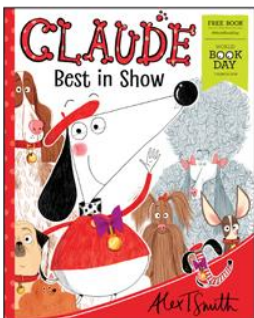
Thursday 7th March is World Book Day. This year we are bringing maths and reading together by basing our activities during the day on a book that is all about numbers. 'The Great Divide – a Mathematical Marathon' is a story book with a difference:
