As it is British Science Week next week, we are setting an optional homework competition for you to take part in. The theme for the week is 'Journeys' so we would like you to investigate and imagine all the amazing journeys that take place around the world. Here are some topic ideas to get you started:

- What sort of journeys have you made? e.g. holidays.
- Research famous journeys e.g. Amy Johnson's flight alone from Britain to Australia or Charles Darwin's journey on the HMS Beagle.
- Think about journeys that might be made in the future
- Other than travel, what other journeys can you think of? E.g. life cycles of animals or plants, the water cycle, or the life cycles of materials such as plastics.

We would like you to produce a poster but it must be:

- 2D (flat) – if you make a model, you need to send a photo of it
- On A4 or A3 paper
- You can use pop up pictures, pull out tabs or use materials such as paint, drawing pencils, crayons and paper.

Posters will be judged on creativity, how well it fits the theme and how well the poster has been made or drawn.

The deadline for entries is Monday 18th March and there will be prizes for the winners and runners up in both LKS2 and UKS2.
