We have been informed by the Council that they are going to be doing some work on the bridge on Dobb Top Road, by Dobb Dyke in order to strengthen it. This is on the bend at the top of the road near the junction with Dobb Lane. The works will take place from 15th April 2019 to approximately the 24th June 2019, approximately 10 weeks. This will be a complete closure with no through path for vehicles. There will be a small pedestrian crossing put in place to allow access by those on foot.
