# Bikeability LEVEL 1

## PARENT INFORMATION & CONSENT FORM

**Bikeability Level 1 is a FREE cycling course for children to develop their basic control skills and gain more confidence to use their cycles more often. This is a national scheme funded by the Department for Transport delivered by Qualified Instructors (QIS checked).**

Sessions take place in an environment away from cars or traffic, typically on a school playground. Children will learn how to fit their own helmets, carry out a simple bike check, get on a bike, start cycling, then stop and get off and using gears (if fitted) on their own bikes. Progressing to controlling the bike with one hand, stopping quickly if necessary and to look around when riding, including behind without wobbling. Those who achieve all of the outcomes will be awarded a Bikeability Level 1 badge and certificate.

Children typically start Bikeability once they have learnt to ride. If your child wants to learn to cycle please talk to us or the class teacher direct for advice.

- \* Parental Consent
- \* A road worthy bike (CTL also recommend a helmet but in the event of not owning one we would not prevent them from taking part with your signed permission)
- \* Suitable outdoor clothing
