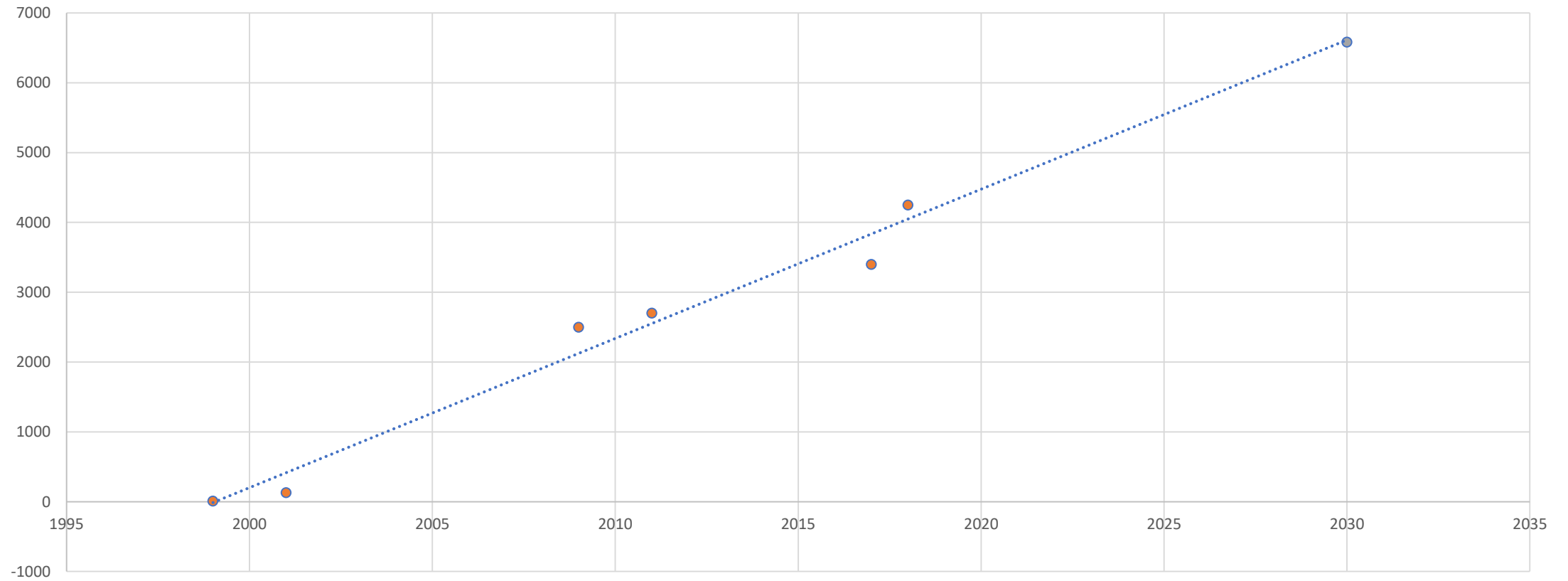


Bird's Eye View of Lower Cambourne



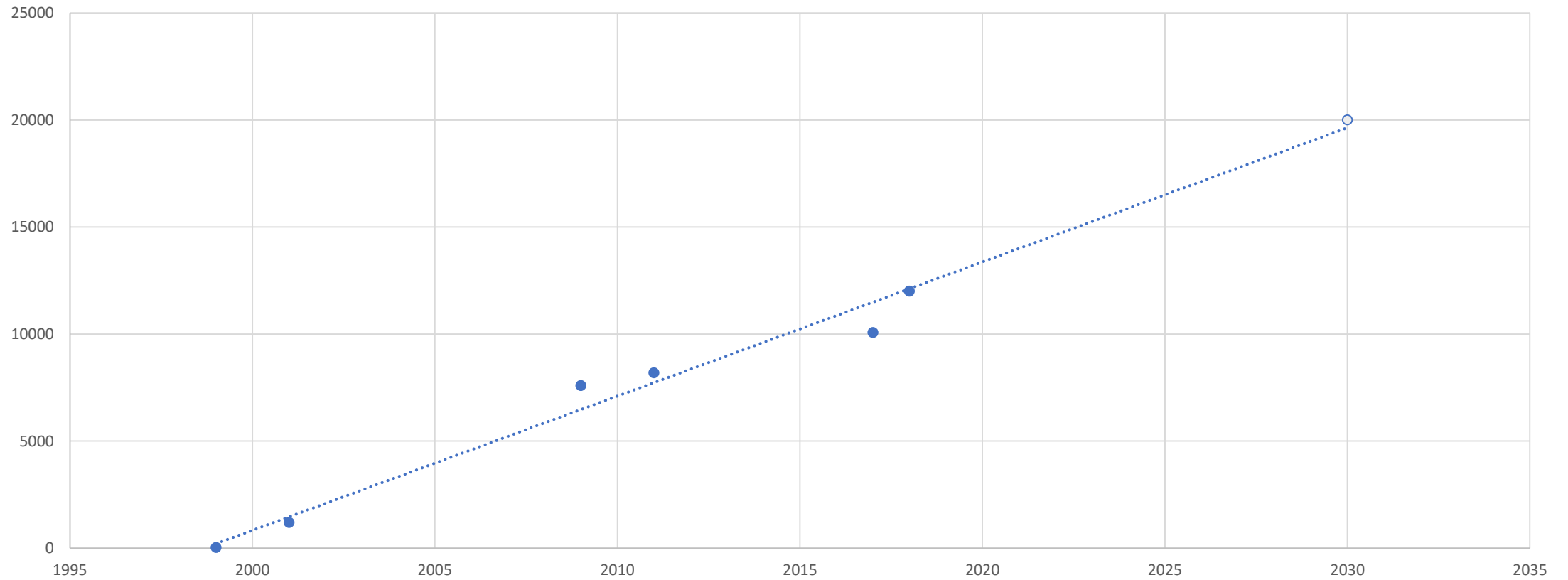
