Literacy

In Literacy this week we have been learning new vocabulary based around our topic of Chinese New Year and have played memory and visual games with the children, such as 'I Spy' and 'Kim's Game'. They have learnt about the traditions associated with Chinese New Year and have been cleaning our home corner and restaurant to get ready for the New Year celebrations next week. We have introduced the sound 'u' as the sound of the week.

Maths

This week in Maths we have begun to introduce the concept of measuring to the children. They have looked at length and height and have had a go at deciding whether objects are big or small, tall or short and then ordered objects from smallest to biggest.

Topic

Our Chinese restaurant has continued to be popular this week and the children have been preparing food for each other using the Chinese menus available in the role play area. They have tried Chinese noodles and prawn crackers and had a think about which was their favourite out of the two choices. They have also found out about some of the traditions associated with Chinese New Year and the origins of customs such as the dragon dance.
