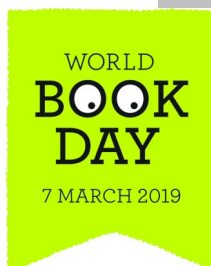

Nursery have had an exciting week with their Launch Day visit from our Local Police.



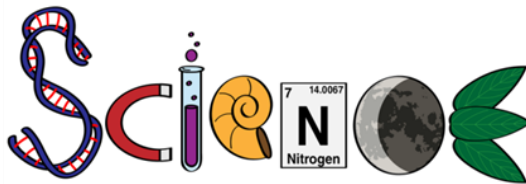
## E-Safety Top Tips
