



Bikeability L1 Information Letter in school time (not a consent letter)

Dear Year 4 Parent/Guardian

On Friday 10th May 2019, Year 4 children have been offered the opportunity to take part in a Bikeability Level 1 course **FREE of Charge** during school time. This is a national scheme funded by the Department for Transport and provided through Cheshire East Council. Level 1 takes place in an environment away from cars and traffic, typically on the school playground. There are a number of outcomes to be taught at Level 1 where your child will gain basic cycle skills including, bike safety checks, starting & stopping under control, manoeuvring, signalling and using gears (if fitted) correctly during the 2 hour session. On successful completion your child will receive a badge and certificate. This course then enables your child to progress onto Bikeability Level 2 on-road training (if they wish) in Year 5 or 6 this is also funded and offered annually by your school.

We at Cyclist Training Ltd recommend the use of a cycling helmet but in the event of the child not owning one we would not prevent them from taking part. Parental permission is required if not wearing a helmet.

To take part your child requires;

1. The use of their own or a friend's maintained bike (and helmet).
2. A signed parental consent form returned by Wednesday 27th March 2019.
3. Suitable outdoor clothing appropriate to weather conditions.
