In Maths this week, we have been learning all about money and set up a toy shop in the classroom where children have been buying and selling items, focusing on recognising the coins and linking them to price tags. The focus next week will move on to ordering numbers to 20, being able to identify the largest and smallest out of two numbers and finding 1 more and 1 less than a given number.
