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Dear Parents,

It has been good to catch up with you all during parent's evening this week and share your child's progress and learning with you. Please remember to fill out the parents' voice and Technology questionnaire and return them as soon as possible. Technology is part of the Early Years Curriculum and we know that children often have access to a wider range of technology within the home than we can offer in school so it would be great if you could complete the questionnaire to add to our evidence for this area of learning. In Phonics next week, we will be reviewing the digraphs 'ur, ow and oi'. Please continue to use the Phonics packs in your child's bookbag to help them become really familiar with these sounds as well as the other digraphs we have been learning. Please find a formation sheet in your child's bookbag for the letter 's', which consolidates the handwriting we have been practising in school this week.

We are now thinking about Spring and learning about the changes that happen and looking for signs of Spring around us. Next week, the children will be doing a Literacy task based on Spring, so it would be great if you are out and about at the weekend to look for signs of Spring together. We are

also hoping to create a 'Spring' interest table and would love the children to contribute to it. This could be photos or pictures of signs of Spring or things they have collected.

In Maths this week we have been looking at ordering numbers to 20. Next week we will be thinking about 1 more and 1 less, using the symbols +/- and writing number sentences.

Next Friday it is Red Nose Day and we will be making some cakes with the children during the week. We are planning to sell the cakes after school on Friday, outside the Foundation classrooms, for 20p each. You are welcome to come in with your child immediately after pick up and buy a cake or two! Please come and support us as all the money will go towards the Red Nose Day fund.
