## **Policy for Children who Cycle or Scooter to School**

A pupil may only bring a cycle/scooter on to school premises when permitted to do so by the Headteacher. All cyclists and scooter riders should dismount when entering school premises.

1. Cyclists, if not accompanied by their parent/carer, should have completed a Hampshire cycle training course.
2. Cyclists/scooter riders are expected to maintain their cycles/scooters in good working order. Checks may be carried out at anytime.
3. A helmet should be worn when cycling, which meets current safety regulations.
4. Cyclists and scooter riders should be encouraged to wear bright and conspicuous clothing.
5. The security of cycles and scooters are the responsibility of the individual and measures must be taken to protect against theft. The school accepts no responsibility for the safety of the cycle/scooter whilst on school premises.
6. The cyclist and scooter rider must have a valid permit to ride to school, which will be issued by the Headteacher. The permit will be issued following receipt of a satisfactorily completed form of application. This permit can be withdrawn at anytime if a cyclist/scooter rider disregards the guidelines.
