Curriculum News

Week Beginning 11th March 2019

This week we will be looking at the different weather conditions which we have in spring; windy, sunny, cloudy and rainy. We will be making weather wheels and creating weather boxes, for example a windy day box will contain homemade kites and wind chimes. The children have been enjoying our new animal rescue centre role play area and we are continuing to build upon this by adding our own writing and pictures.

In our Outdoor Exploration session on Thursday we will be looking at the frogs in the pond and learning about a frog's life cycle. We are also looking at the changes in our environment, such as the addition of blossom on the trees.

In Maths we will be continuing with halving and doubling, and will be going on a 'halving and doubling picnic' where the children will be sharing out food between friends. The children will be writing a shopping list for this at the beginning of the week, thinking about what foods can be doubled and halved easily.

As a reminder; if you would like additional tricky words please ask your child's teacher for some more.

Have a go at halving food, for example halving a pack of smarties between 2 people.
Make a 'bug hotel' in your garden for the local mini-beasts, made out of different materials.
