


Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Enhancing Learning

We will be...

- We will be working with the PE coaches to develop our core muscles and strength.

Communication and Language


We will be...

- using sentences to ask adults for things we want help with.
- learning new words for different objects and using them correctly by ourselves in the right way.
- Beginning to ask questions about what is happening in Nursery.
- speaking to the children and the other members of staff in and around school.

Understanding the World

We will be...

- Observing our Nursery Environment talking about what we can see .
- Observing the outdoors and talking about what we can see and how it has changed.
- Creating our own small world based on the stories we have read and our own interests.
- Investigating how the computers in our classroom work and how we can keep safe when using them.
- Talking about home and special events that might be happening.

Literacy

We will be...

- Reading a selection of exciting story books together and choosing a library book weekly to enjoy at home.
- Thinking about the stories and using the characters for roleplay activities.
- We will be beginning to orally blend simple words and listening carefully to the sounds we can hear.
- Using lots of different media to mark make.
- Talking about the pictures we have created.

Mathematics

We will be...

- Singing lots of songs that help us learn our numbers.
- Looking at numbers in our environment and experimenting with creating symbols to represent them.
- Solving problems involving numbers and money in our roleplay areas.
- Constructing buildings and talking about the shapes we can see in the bricks.

Expressive Arts

We will be...

- Joining in singing Nursery Rhymes and completing the actions.
- Experimenting with different musical instruments and the different sounds that they make.
- Joining in ring games and copying moves in dances.
- Create our own dance moves.
- Creating stories in our roleplay areas and small world.
- Experimenting with colours and patterns.
