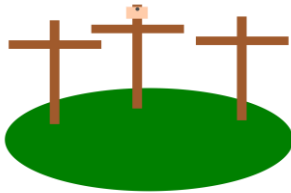


### Comic Relief 2019

### Easter Bingo!

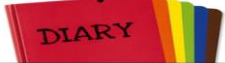
