LEARNING CHALLENGE: HOW DO I BECOME A SUPERHERO?

Expressive Arts & Design

This half term we will be exploring musical instruments and creating our own piece of music. We will also be continuing to encourage children to be creative to represent their own thoughts, ideas and feelings through Art, Music, Technology and Dance.

Understanding the World

The children will look at the natural world and animals with super powers e.g. chameleons and their camouflage.

We will also look at everyday heroes and how some people have overcome difficulties to become heroes.

Literacy

We will be continuing our learning of Phase 2, 3 & 4 sounds and applying these into reading and writing sentences. We will also continue to look at tricky words within all these phases.

We will have a big focus on independent sentences including capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Mathematics

We will continue to look at addition and subtraction but this term we will be counting on and back. We will continue to look at shapes and their properties and introduce 3D shapes. We will also be looking at doubling and halving.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

In R.E. we will be looking at Easter. We will be looking at different Easter foods and retelling the Easter Story through role-play. We will expect children to solve problems that occur within their friendships more independently and become more confident to say what they do and don't like.

Physical Development

We will be looking at outdoor games this half term. The children will also be encouraged to make healthy choices within the Snack area and become more independent when making choices about food and how to remain healthy.

Communication & Language

This half term the children will be creating a Superhero den where the children can work with each other and take on the roles of different superheroes.
