The Y5 children will be attending the Winter Festival of Sport on Tuesday 5th March at South Hunsley. They will need a packed lunch, PE kit and water bottle.

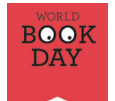
If you haven't already done so, please go online www.simsagora.co.uk to give consent for your child to travel on the coach.
