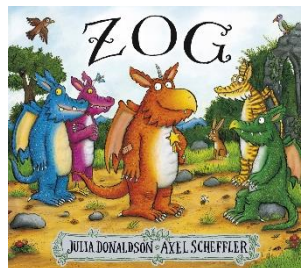
Hazel Class Assembly
