Lenten Stalls

When you have finished your stall, add the money you have raised to your class CAFOD box. You will need to draw the winners of your stall out in class and then deliver any prizes to that pupil's classroom; we will not be announcing winners in the Gold Book assembly as it sadly takes too much time. Y6 pupils will put out tables at 10.30am each morning in readiness for your stalls (weather permitting). Good luck raising funds – remember why you are doing such a great thing and think about how it could help other people in our world.
