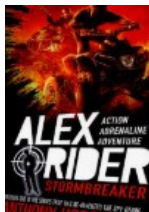


English

We are continuing to read Stormbreaker by Anthony Horowitz as our text but we are moving on to non-fiction writing. The children will be learning how to write an explanation text and a persuasion text.



Reading will include a mixture of guided and independent comprehension activities as well as a look at the last assessments that the children completed.



Maths

We will continue to regularly practice arithmetic. We will also be covering algebra, ratio, and measurement including perimeter, area and volume.



DT

In DT we will look at the history of design and technology and how its development has shaped the world. Our theme for this half term is bridges and we will be developing the children's skills and understanding of design, particularly in terms of stiffening and strengthening complex structures.

SCIENCE
