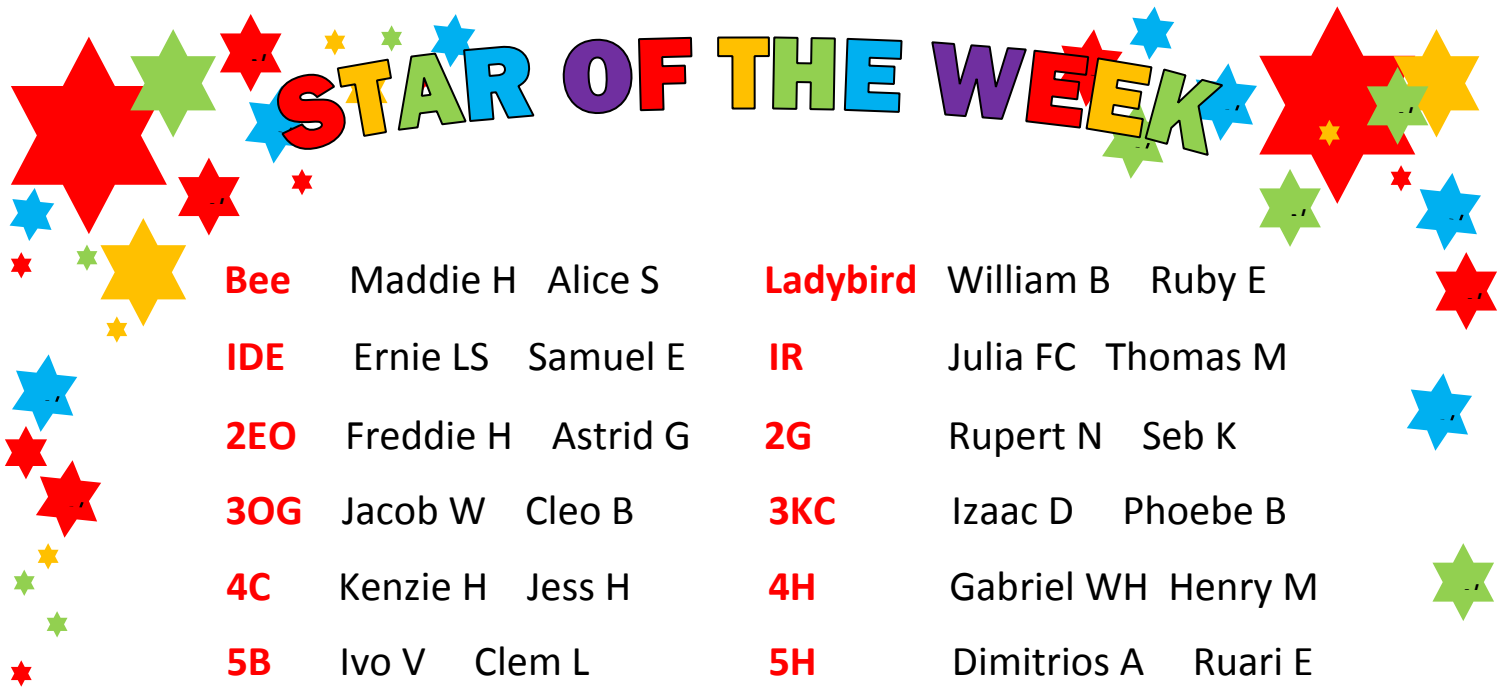
Code of Dress: Please can I remind parents that all hair longer than collar length needs to be tied back – thank you. Please also note that boots are not allowed to be worn.
