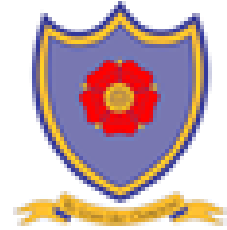


# Worsley Mesnes Primary School Newsletter

Come along to our Year 4 Drumming Concert on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April at 2.30pm.

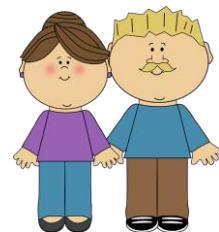
### Community Dance Session at Worsley Mesnes CP School

### **Wigan Authority – Education Penalty Notice for Non-School Attenders**

A letter has been sent home from Wigan Council regarding penalty notice for school non-attenders.

The local authority can issue a penalty notice to parents/carers if a child has missed a number of sessions without permission from school. If your child falls within one or more of these categories within a 12 week period:

- fac**
- 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence with under 90% attendance
  - 20 sessions (10 days) of unauthorised absence
  - Persistently arrives late for school after the close of registration.
