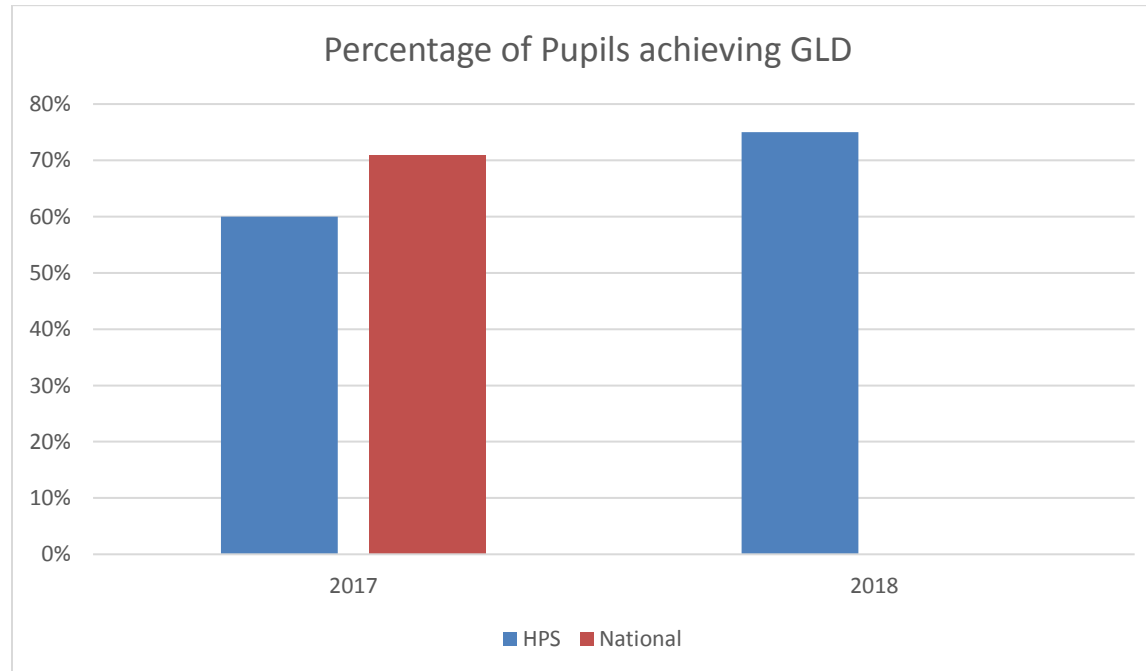

It can be seen that the number and percentage of pupils achieving GLD across all areas has **significantly increased**. This means that HPS exceeds the 2017 National figure of 71%.



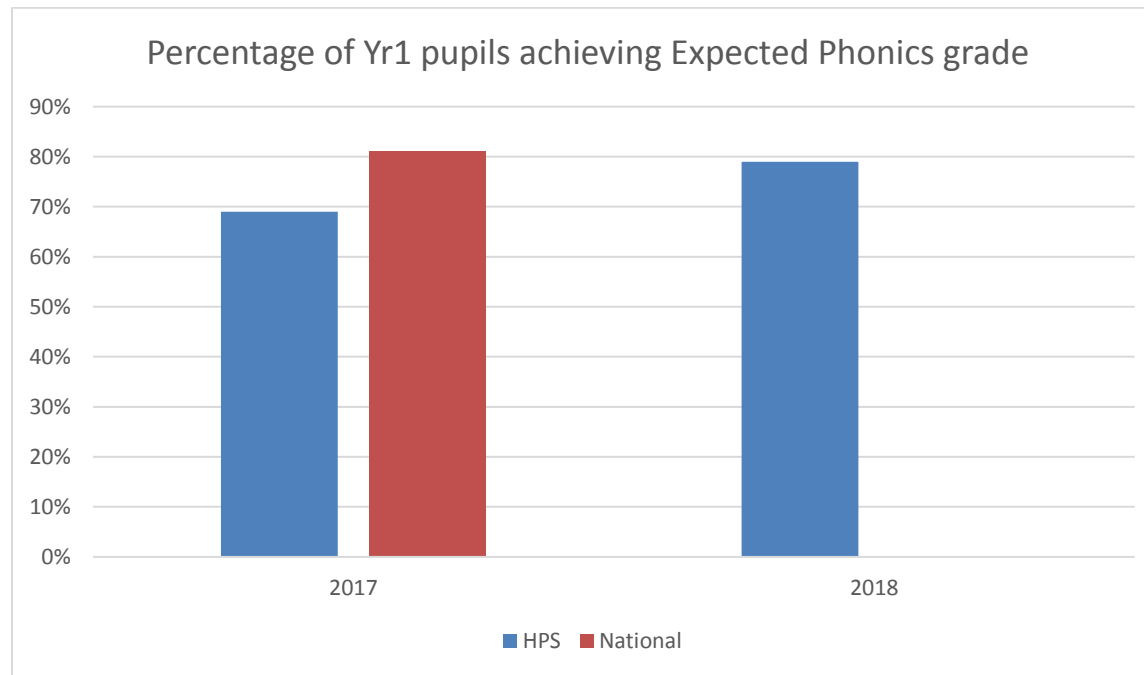
## Phonics Data

It can be seen that in 2017-18, the number and percentage of pupils achieving the expected Phonics Grade in Year 1 has risen from 69% to 79%. This means HPS is in line with the 2017 National figure of 81%.

**By the end of Year 2, 92% of pupils at HPS had achieved the expected grade.** This is a rise from 2017 and is in line with 2017 National figures.

In Table 3 it can be seen that by the end of KS1, pupils at HPS have achieved in line with, or above National Standards at Expected level across all subjects and at Greater Depth level in RWM Combined scores. There has been great improvement across all subjects from 2017, particularly at Greater Depth.

Table 4 shows that all pupils who previously achieved GLD by the end of Reception (2016) achieved at least Expected level by the end of KS1. Of the HPS pupils who had not achieved GLD (2016), over 47% achieved at least the Expected standard.

Table 5 shows that HPS has made good progress across Reading, Writing, SPAG and Science at Expected Level from 2017. This has diminished the difference between HPS and National figures. HPS has made significant progress in Maths from 2017 and has exceeded National figures at Expected Level.

Table 6 shows that:

-All pupils who achieved at a high level (Prior High) in KS1 (2014) achieved at Expected in Writing and Maths.

-A large proportion of those who achieved at Expected level (Prior Middle) in KS1 (2014) achieved at Expected level in KS2 in 2017 (in line with or above National figures).

-A significant proportion of pupils who did not achieve the KS1 levels in 2014 achieved at Expected level in KS2 in 2018. These figures exceed National Expectations at Expected level.
