



## DUNHOLME ST CHAD'S CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL INFORMATION LEAFLET 3 School Uniform

We promote the wearing of school uniform to give children a sense of belonging and pride in our school. We ask parents to support us by encouraging their children to come to school tidily and suitably dressed.

There is a choice of uniform featuring the school logo (St Chad's Cross) which can be purchased from Uniform Direct on the High Street or online at [www.uniform-direct.com](http://www.uniform-direct.com). The same items of clothing without the logo e.g. a plain pale blue polo shirt can be purchased from a range of stores and are also able to be worn in school. **Please note other logos are not acceptable.**

- **Sweatshirts, jumpers or cardigans** in navy;
- **Shirts, t-shirts, or blouses** in a light blue or white;
- **Trousers, skirts and pinafore dresses** in grey or navy;
- **Summer dresses** (striped, checked or plain) in light blue or navy;
- **Summer shorts** in grey or navy;
- **Socks or tights** in white, navy grey or black only;
- **Sensible footwear** shoes (black) or sandals (black, brown, blue or white) that can be fastened securely for the range of activities children participate in. Trainers should not be worn routinely. If your child needs to wear trainers for a short period, please let the school know. In very cold or wet weather children may wear boots or wellingtons to school, changing into suitable footwear at school.
- **PE Kit** - Sports or athletic shorts/skirts in navy blue, plain tee shirts in white/pale blue, socks, trainers. Trainers may be worn for outdoor activities. The PE kit should be brought into school in a separate PE bag.
- **Hair accessories** - Hair Accessories should be kept simple to tie back or secure hair. Children with mid-length and long hair are expected to tie their hair back throughout the school day. Hair should be tied back using striped, checked or plain ribbons or scrunchies in light or navy blue.
- **Outdoor clothes** - Wellies, waterproof jacket and waterproof trousers. Classes will be informed when they need these items for outdoor learning.

**Please make sure that all your child's clothing has his or her name on and that your child knows where to look for their name.**

### **Nail varnish, jewellery and (temporary) tattoos**

We request that children do not wear coloured nail varnish at school. A small watch and simple pierced earrings may be worn. However, earrings must be removed or taped over before PE lessons. Children need to be able to remove their own earrings. Tattoos acquired from an organised school event can be worn the for the remainder of the week following the event.

### **Lost Property**

Lost property which is not named will be kept in school until the end of the term. If it is unclaimed on the last day of term then it will be disposed of.
