1. Letters and Sounds

Throughout Nursery we play phase 1 phonics games which help to reinforce all the vital skills that children need for early reading and writing. Go to the following website and choose some of the phase 1 games to play with your child.

2. Eye Spy

Place a group of objects on a table and name each object.

Play eye spy in the traditional way, emphasising the first sound in each word.

3. World Book Day

Draw the Character you are dressing as and label them.

What was your favourite part? Retell the story to a grown up in your own words.

4. When I Grow Up

Ask your child what they would like to be when they grow up and encourage them to draw a picture. Help your child to hold the pencil effectively, remembering the pompom trick you were shown on Class Dojo.
