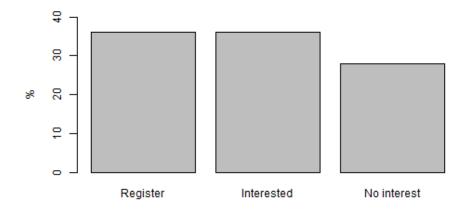

1: Respondents younger than 26 years old

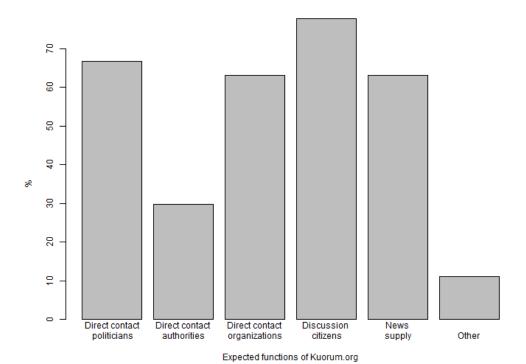


2: Respondents older than 26 years

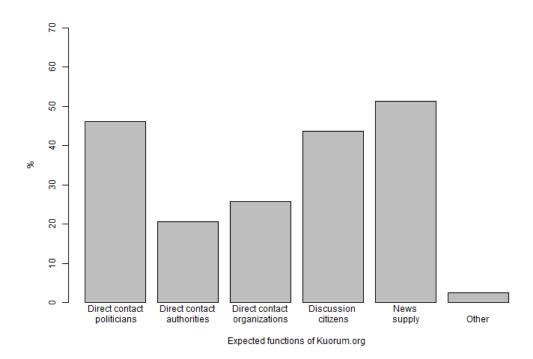
The younger citizens are not less interested in such an offer of online political tool.

#### 3: Respondents younger 26 years old

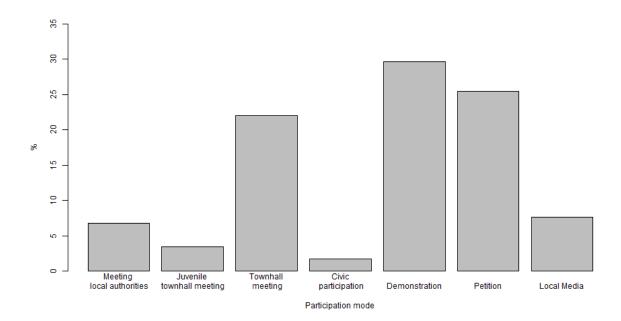

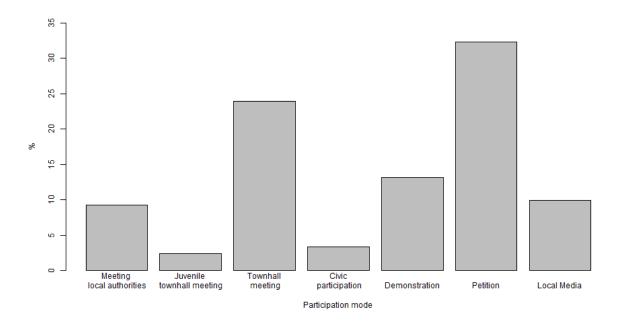
In general, younger citizens expect more specific functionalities of the online political tool. In particular, they seek to have more direct contact with different organizations via such tools.

#### 5: Respondents younger than 26 years

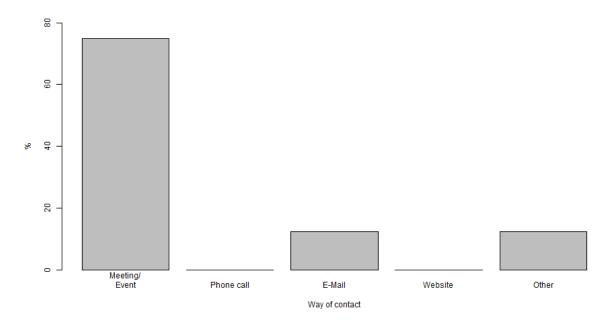

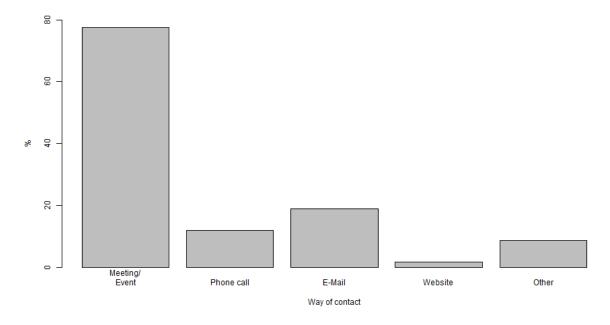
Younger citizens are also involved in politics. In particular, they have already involved in demonstration than the older citizens.

Did you (try to) contact a member of the local council in Mannheim to express your opinion in the last 12 months? Yes, ...



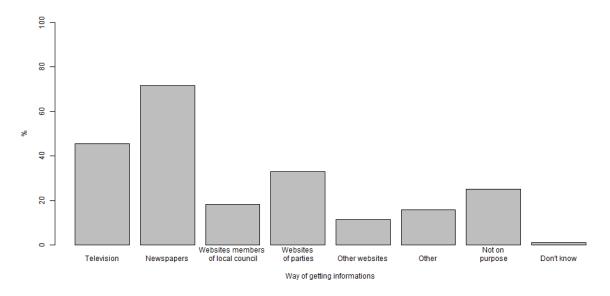

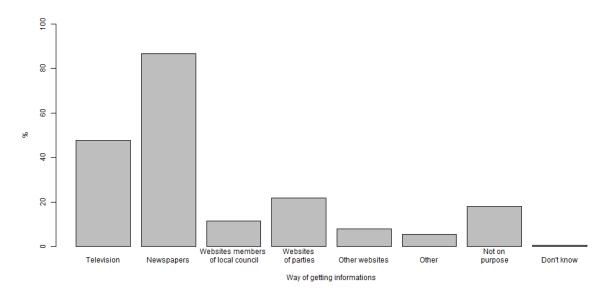

### 9: Respondents younger than 26 years

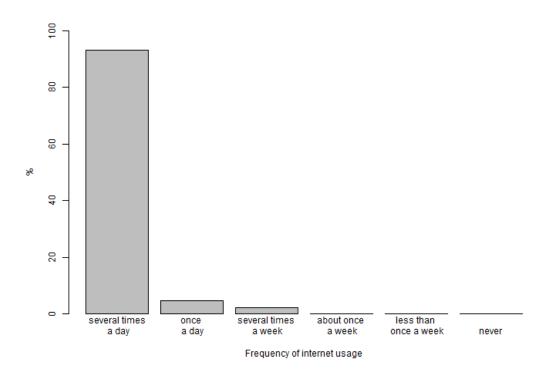

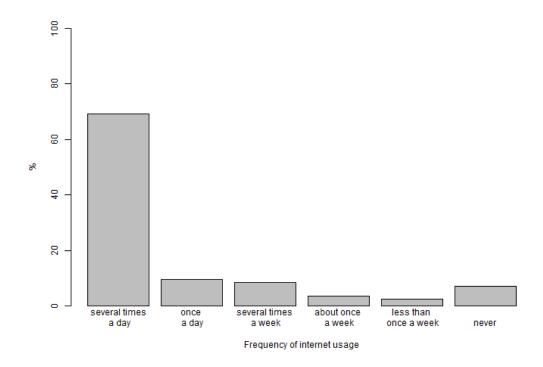
It is clear to see that the younger citizens seek political information in the online space, in particular websites.

How often do you use the internet?



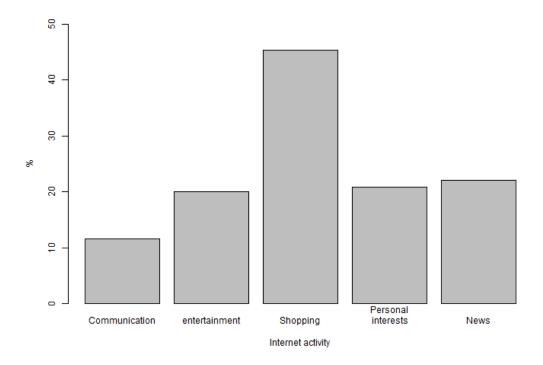
#### 11: Respondents younger than 26 years



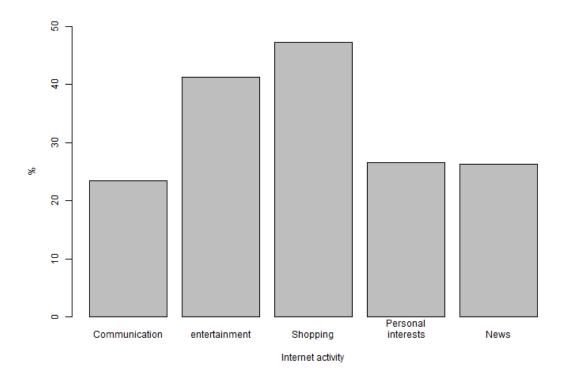

13: Respondents younger than 26 years

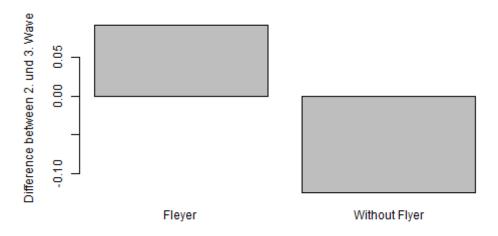

### Effect of the project activity on political efficacy of citizens

### The effect of the flyer on younger citizens' political efficacy.

The respondents who received the flyer of our platform have improved their political efficacy while those without the fyler had a lower level of political efficacy. This indicates that the knowledge about the online platform itself can improve the citizens' political efficacy.



#### The effect of the event on younger citizens' political efficacy.

The respondents in the part of city Seckenheim had no change in their political efficacy level. However, the youth in the other part of Mannheim and Ladenburg had a quite lower level of political efficacy due to some unknown factors, which also are expected in Seckenheim. That is, we can conclude that the joint event had a positive effect on political efficacy, which canceled out the unknown factor.
