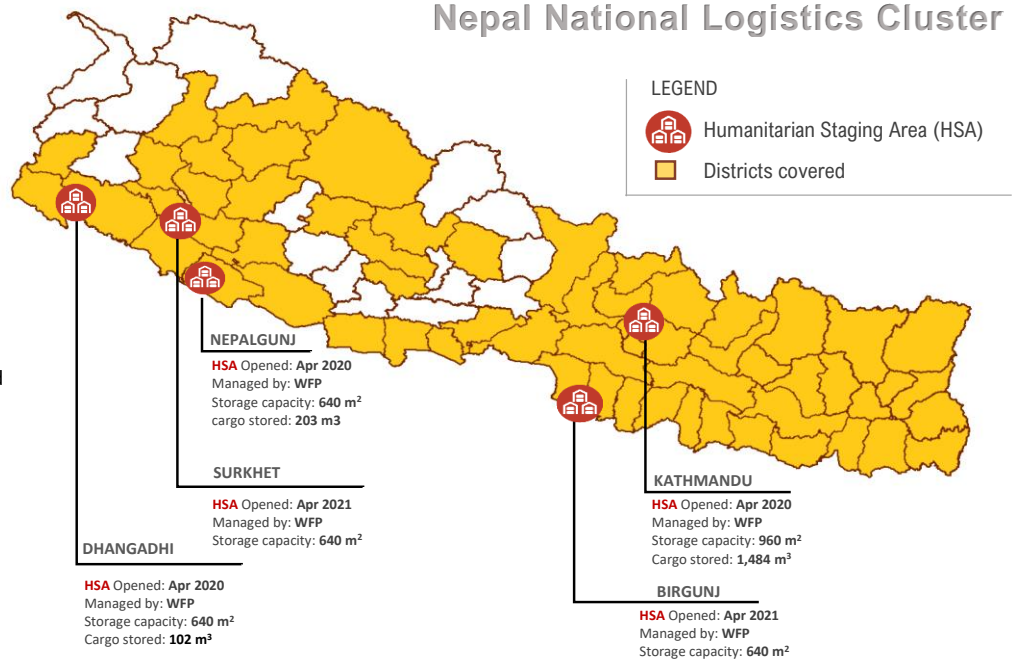

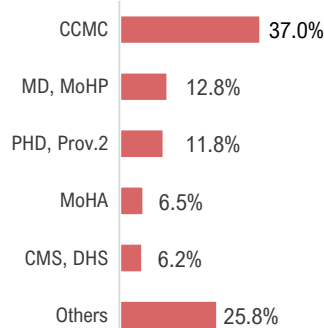

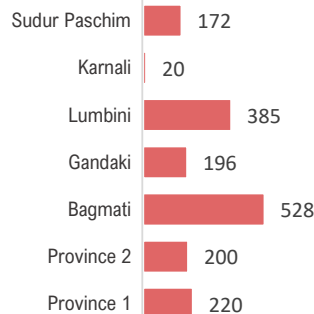
### TONNAGE DELIVERY BY RESPONSE



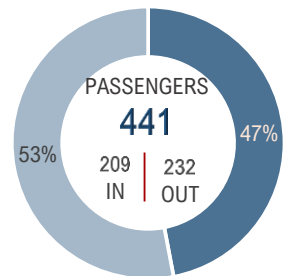
### TOP 5 SERVICE USER
