- **Logistics Needs, Gaps and Challenges**

- The rainy season has started in several states of Sudan.
- In east Sudan all the main roads remain accessible.
- The Hamdayet reception point and Village 8 are not accessible.
- The roads to Umm Rakuba camp and Neiva are accessible.
- In the Kordofan area access is possible, but with some difficulties in both south and west Kordofan.
- In north Darfur the roads are accessible.
- In east, west Darfur and the Geneina area some roads have been affected by heavy rains
- Physical access constraints updates will be shared by the Logistics Sector.

- **Update from UNHAS**

- One of the Khartoum based fixed wing aircraft will be proceeding on routine maintenance between the 23 - 27 July. This will impact Port Sudan, Kadugli and Damazine routes.
- UNHAS will remain operational during the holidays for any emergency operation.
