1. Air Operations Updates

Priority Locations

- The list of the Inter-Cluster Coordination Group (ICCG) priority locations is as follows:
- Reachable by air:
 - **GPAA – Pibor:** Kozchal, Manyabol, Verteth; monitoring Gumuruk, Pibor Town, Labrab and Lekuangole;
 - **Jonglei- Duk:** Poktap, Duk, Payuel, Padiet and Panyang;
 - **Jonglei- Twic:** Twic East.
- Reachable by road:
 - **Central Equatoria – Yej;**
 - **Central Equatoria – Juba;**
 - **Central Equatoria - Kajo Keji:** Loggo;
 - **Central Equatoria - Lainya:** Lainya, Katigiri and Wonduruba;
 - **NBeG:** Aweil South;
 - **Western Equatoria – Yambio, Ezo, Tambura, Nagero, Nzara;**

- **Lakes – Yirol West;**
- **Warrap – Gogrial West;**
- **Warrap - Tonj East:** Makuach, Wunlit, Payeng, Ananatak, Palal and Paliang payam;
- **Warrap -Tonj South:** Tonj, Manyangok, Thiet and Jak Payam;
- **Warrap - Tonj North:** Rual Bet, Pagol, Manalor, Akop, Aliek, Kirik, Awul, Ethieng-Puol, Warrap Town;
- **Unity – Rubkona:** Bentiu IDP camp/town.
- Reachable by river:
 - **Jonglei – Fangak:** New Fangak and Old Fangak;
 - **Upper Nile – Panyikang, Fashoda;**
 - **Jonglei -Ayod:** Western flank Wau, Pajiek, Mogok and Pagil;
 - **Jonglei- Akobo:** Wechkoang (Dengjok Payam), Markath (Bilkey Payam), Wechyeryier (Nyadit Payam), Wechgokthiang (Alali/Gakdong Payam).

2. Road Transport & Convoy Updates

- The latest information on physical road accessibility as displayed on the [Physical Access Constraints Map](#) was shared with partners.
- Most roads in Jonglei, Upper Nile and Central/South Unity are no longer accessible.
- The Western Corridor is passable until Abiemnhom. The road from Abiemnhom to Bentiu/Rubkona is no longer passable and Western Corridor Convoys terminate at Abiemnhom.
- Organisations were requested to share any physical road access updates with the Logistics Cluster via southsudan.clustercargo@wfp.org.
- The Logistics Cluster is also still facilitating road convoys from Juba to Lainya and Yei, Mundri and Yambio, Torit and Kapoeta, and to Kajo Keji.
- The Beyond Responses, providing road transport services from Bentiu and Wau, are still serving locations accessible by road, and partners are encouraged to make use of them while possible. For Bentiu, the destinations served include Pariang/Yida and Manga Port. For Wau, most locations are still accessible, except for Tonj East and Raja due to poor road conditions.
- Organisations can consult the latest departure dates and deadlines in the [Weekly Transport Plan](#), shared every Monday. The road convoy schedule for August-September can be found [here](#).

3. River Operations Updates

- Barge #7/#8 is to depart this week from Bor to Tonga, Pagner, Ata3/Diel, Canal and Malakal.
- The next barge from Bor to Renk and destinations along the White Nile and Sobat has a tentative departure date of 10 October.
- The Logistics Cluster is currently trialling the new river route from Bor to Ganyiel and Nyal, joining the WFP food convoy with one boat with non-food items (NFIs).

- The first ever Logistics Cluster boat convoy departed today 7 September from Bor to Akobo, serving Mandeng, Jikmir, Maker and Makak as well. The boat convoy from Bor to New Fangak, Old Fangak, Menime and Haat also departed today.
- The latest information on planned departure dates for river movements can be found in the [Weekly Transport Plan](#). Departure dates for river movements are subject to change due to the large variety of factors influencing a timely departure.

4. AOB/Discussion
