Background

The National Logistics Cluster provides support to the humanitarian community through the coordination of logistics operations and addresses identified logistics gaps. WFP, as co-lead agency of the National Logistics Cluster, in cooperation with the Ministry of Transport and Public Works, engages with the various stakeholders to facilitate transport, storage and other logistics activities in Malawi.

Coordination & Information Management

- In close coordination with the Ministry of Transport and Public Works, the National Logistics Cluster chaired **bi-weekly online meetings** presenting national response updates, general COVID-19 updates, lean season response updates, the COVID-19 Response Plan, and related ongoing activities to partners.
- In addition, the National Logistics Cluster participated in national **inter-cluster coordination** group meetings on a weekly basis.



COVID-19, National Logistics Cluster Support & General Logistics Services

- The National Logistics cluster supported with the installation of ventilation panels on MSU's (tents) at Lilongwe Girls Secondary School
- The National Logistics cluster has supported with the deployment and installation of 4 big tents (32m x 10m) at Mzuzu Central Hospital to be used as a field hospital
- The National Logistics cluster has supported with the deployment and installation of 1 big tent (32m x 10m) and 1 small tent (6.5m x 8m) to Mwanza Border to be used as a testing facility.
