LOGISTICS CLUSTER

The Logistics Cluster, when activated in an emergency, is responsible for providing logistics coordination, information management; and, where there is a gap in logistics infrastructure, WFP, as the lead agency, acts as a 'Provider of Last Resort' by offering common logistics services to support the humanitarian community in their response operations.

Coordination & Information

Coordination units and dedicated staff are operating in Monrovia, Freetown and Conakry. Regular coordination meetings held in all the above locations.

The Logistics Cluster is currently activated in Liberia and provides access to common services for humanitarian organisations in Liberia, Sierra Leone and Guinea.

Temporary Storage

Logistics Cluster provides access to 11 Forward Logistics Bases (FLBs) with 26 Mobile Storage Units (MSUs) and 3 Logistics Hubs in the affected region by WFP common services.
