
Use pallets for stacking of items



Secure sharp edges



Ensure batteries are disconnected



Use professional equipment and a ramp to handle heavy drums/barrels



DON'T


Risk damage by placing boxes in a disorderly manner



Transport sharp objects unsecured



Transport connected batteries



Use damaged drums which are prone to leaking

Ensure all cargo is dry before loading

Handle bagged cargo with extra care





Be aware that spillage can damage aircraft and compromise safety

Ensure correct marking to protect cargo, assets and people.





DON'T

Load cargo soaked in water



Handle bagged cargo carelessly resulting in damage and clean up

Load cargo if leaking



Load incorrectly labelled or packaged cargo
