



# WREC LOG.IE MAP: WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING INFRASTRUCTURE

## INTRODUCTION

The LogIE tool has been designed for and by humanitarian logistics responders to improve coordination, information sharing and the quantity and quality of the data available in emergency response and preparedness.

The WREC Waste management facilities mapping shares information on existing country waste management and recycling facilities to humanitarian organizations during emergencies.

This guide has been developed to provide a quick guidance to users on how to use the LogIE map.

### **BASIC OPTIONS**

1. Access the map through the link: <a href="https://logie.logcluster.org/?op=wrec">https://logie.logcluster.org/?op=wrec</a>








#### 2. Search facilities using filters:

- Filter by *Hazardous* or *Non-hazardous* waste: visualize all type of facilities at the same time or only those collecting hazardous waste or those collecting non-hazardous waste.
- Filter by type of *Waste accepted*: visualize only those facilities per type of waste accepted (e.g. cardboards, e-waste, tires, use oil, etc.).



**3. Grouped facilities**: facilities are grouped in the map by proximity. The more you zoom into the map the more facilities you will see. When you click on an icon, you will first select the company interested in, and after clicking on it, you will see detailed information on that facility (e.g. name, location, contact details, different waste accepted, etc.).








## **ADVANCED OPTIONS**

- **4. Visualize data on a table**: Data facility data can be visualized in a data table on the bottom of the map. Columns can be moved on the right or left for an easy reading.
- **5. Filter by Map Extent**: when activated, you will visualize on the table the details of facilities framed on the screen. When inactive, the table will show the entire list of facilities in the map from all countries.
- **6. Download the table:** option to download or all facilities data or only those visible in the screen:
