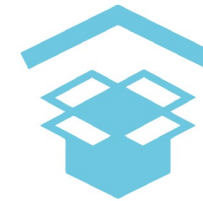

# Operations Support

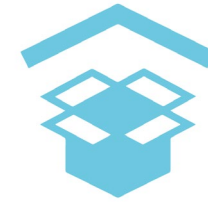

- Secondments of individuals (to a cluster member)
- Specific functions (e.g., airport management, road transport management, warehouse management, customs management, information/communication, etc.)
- Service provisions (e.g., full transportation services from one location to another, including all relevant elements such as warehousing, transport, etc.)
- Asset deployments (e.g., warehouse/truck capacity, forklifts, pallets, etc.)

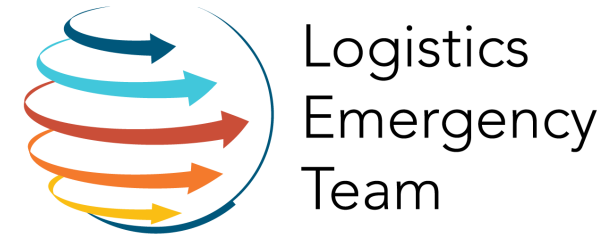


# 2025 Operations Overview

# LET 2.0



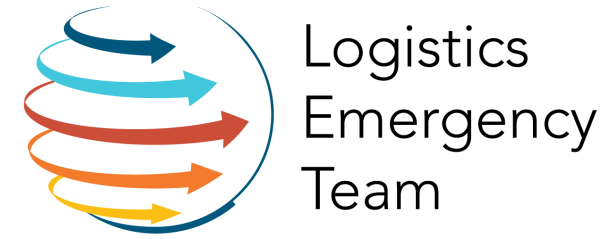
- The LET partnership is in its 20<sup>th</sup> year.
