

Background

South Sudan faces a prolonged humanitarian crisis driven by conflict, floods, and disease. The Sudan conflict has caused cross-border displacement, while flooding isolates communities. The Greater Upper Nile crisis, cholera outbreak, hyperinflation, intercommunal violence, and rising food insecurity overwhelm aid efforts.

The WFP-led Logistics Cluster is essential for sustaining relief. It coordinates logistics, shares information, maps routes, and manages supply chains. As Provider of Last Resort, it offers transport, warehousing, and cargo consolidation to ensure aid reaches hard-to-access areas.


Operational Highlights

- From July to September 2025, the Logistics Cluster facilitated the transport of 1,031 mt of life-saving multi-sectoral humanitarian cargo utilizing common logistics services and road convoys. The cluster reached 24 hard-to-reach locations and supported 73 organizations.
- Of the above, 155 mt representing 15% of multisectoral relief items were airlifted to various locations to support the Greater Upper Nile and cholera response efforts.
- Additionally, 876 mt representing 85% of cargo was delivered to various locations via river transport, using WFP's On Demand Services (ODS) at 50% cost-share modalities.
- One road convoy, carrying an estimated 40 mt of humanitarian cargo, was coordinated to Ayod in Northern Jonglei.
