

Good Chance R&D Opportunities

Good Chance Theatre, creators of *The Jungle* and *The Walk*, is looking for a Stage Manager and two actors to be part of an R&D for a new boundary-pushing poetry-theatre show with their poetry collective Change the Word.



Stage Manager

- **Role:** An experienced Stage Manager to oversee all practical aspects of the R&D including scheduling and running R&D days, arranging props and equipment, notes and recording the R&D, supporting the Artistic Director and other creatives to fulfil the creative vision for the R&D and supporting the Producer in ensuring the smooth running of the R&D.
- **Dates:** 10 days total: 5 days for the R&D week of Monday 28th June - Friday 2nd July 2021, plus 3 prep days between 24th May - 25th June and 2 follow up days by 16 July.
- **Location:** Ideally based in Sheffield or the surrounding area.
- **Fee:** £1,000 total for 10 days - £100 per day (most favoured nations).

Actor/musician

- **Role:** An actor who has experience of workshopping and R&D processes, who can step into a week-long R&D for one day to bring the poetry written in the previous days to life on stage and explore how it could be delivered theatrically. Experience as a musician is a plus.
- **Date:** Wednesday 30th June OR Thursday 1st July.
- **Location:** Ideally based in Sheffield or the surrounding area.
- **Fee:** £100 for the day (most favoured nations).

Informal interviews will be held on a rolling basis - deadline to apply: Wednesday 19th May.
