Purpose of the role

The Stage Manager will be responsible for all aspects of stage and production management of *imagine if*'s new production *"My Old Man"* which is touring the UK this Autumn/Winter.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Travel with 2xcrew and a minimal set (5 items) to 9 venues across the UK
- Leading the get in / get out at venues
- Drive to venues and back to base
- Liaise with theatre / venue staff regarding the show's production and technical requirements
- Run sound and lighting for the show

General

- Adhere to, and actively contribute to *imagine if* policies, including Equalities (diversity, access, equal opportunities), Environmental and Health & Safety.
- To maximise income and minimise expenditure wherever possible, without jeopardising the quality of the work or the reputation of *imagine if*.
- To act always in the best interest of *imagine if*.
