

Dear Grandpa, It's Michael...

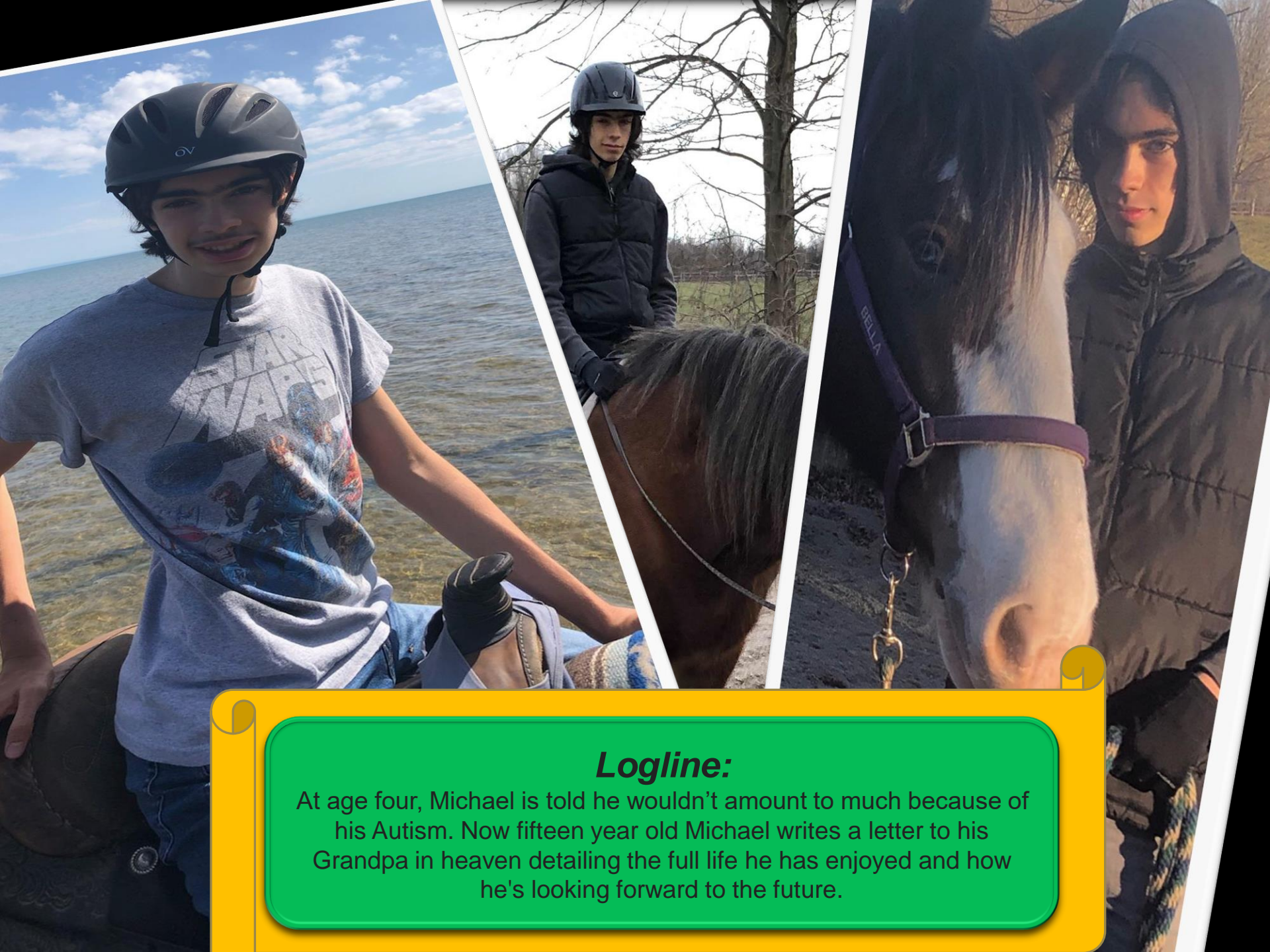
